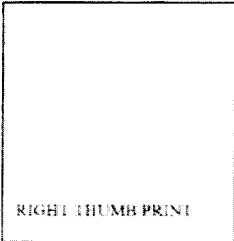

PROBABLE CAUSE:

This incident initiated at [REDACTED] . I, College Resource Officer Leach #212, was assigned to the college as a resource officer. During this incident I was wearing my department issued blue polo with silver color LPD badge on the left chest, LPD shoulder patches, with the reflective words "Lakeland Police" on the back. I was operating a college issued white golf cart with the black words "Police" on the front and both sides.

Witness Briannah Dempsey [REDACTED] advised via [REDACTED] Safety Radio that she observed Defendant Marcus Adams smoking a cigarette by the "JR" Dorm building. This building is a female only dorm building in the center of campus. Dempsey notified Adams he had to leave the campus. Dempsey advised me that Adams failed to obey her order to leave campus and continued to ride his bike around aimlessly for a period of time. Safety Officer Justin Valez also observed the subject disobey to orders to leave in the most direct route. At this time, I determined there was probable cause to arrest Adams for trespass after warning.

The description was a white male on a bike with a backpack on his back. When I arrived in the last known area of Johnson Ave several safety officers were pointing me in the direction, they saw the subject. I wanted to locate the subject to investigate the claims that he was loitering/prowling on campus near the girl's dorm and also due to him not leaving directly after ordered to do so by FSC Safety.

PROBABLE CAUSE:

I located the subject within minutes due to safety officers pointing out his direction of travel. I observed a male matching the description given in the area the safety officers were pointing, which was the 700 block of Charles Street. I was traveling in an east direction on the street and Adams was on a bicycle traveling west on the southside sidewalk.

As I exited the golf cart I pointed to Adams and told him to stop as I walked towards him. He asked "why" so I continued to give him a clear, loud and concise command to stop, so I could talk to him. He looked at me and continued to peddle his bicycle away from me actively physically my commands for him to stop. At this point Officer Smith #302 came around the corner in his fully marked police SUV. At this point Adams appeared to try to get off his bike to run away, however, he got caught on his bike causing him to fall to the ground. We closed the distance on Adams to try to place him into handcuffs, at which point he tried to kick me twice. While attempting to place Adams I handcuffs he began tensing his body and pulling away from Officer Smith. Adams was also violently thrashing his body preventing Officer Smith and myself from taken him into custody and resisting all commands given to him. I yelled "Taser" multiple times and deployed my department issued Conductive Electrical Weapon (CEW). I deployed the taser

which appeared to be affective. Officer Smith #302 and Marlowe #325 were able to eventually secure the subject in handcuffs. I held the taser on the subject in case there was a need for further deployments.

Search incident to arrest Adams was wearing a black bag strapped around the torso of his body. Through a search of the bag revealed 2 glass pipes containing a clear crystalline residue. I immediately recognized these to be items of drug paraphernalia commonly used for smoking illegal narcotics. I suspected the residue inside to be methamphetamine. A methamphetamine field test kit was utilized on the glass pipes which resulted in a presumptive positive color-changing reaction for methamphetamine.

A further search of the bag revealed a small metal black box. Inside the black box were two plastic baggies containing clear crystal rocks. The substance was immediately recognized and suspected to be methamphetamine. A methamphetamine field test kit was utilized on the crystal rock substance which resulted in a presumptive positive color-changing reaction for methamphetamine.

The first baggie contained 5.64 Grams of methamphetamine and the second baggie contained 3.58 Grams of Methamphetamine. The total weight of the

methamphetamine collected was 9.22 Grams.

Through my investigation I determined probable cause exists to charge Adams with Trespassing on school grounds after warning, Possession of Methamphetamine, possession of drug paraphernalia, assault on a law enforcement officer, and resisting an officer without violence.
