Therefore, there was evidence that the officer failed to follow proper procedures, and disciplinary action was taken against the subject member. There was no action taken against the other department members regarding their involvement in this matter. Please be advised that the Board of Police Commissioners and the Office of the Chief of Police have been apprised of your complaint and the outcome of this investigation.

Further, this office and the Board of Police Commissioners would like to apologize for the span of time it took for us to investigate your complaint. We believe the extensive amount of time spent on this investigation was necessary in order to achieve a fair and impartial recommendation. It was a lengthy and thorough investigation which, in our opinion, accomplished the appropriate resolution.
