NARRATIVE: The undersigned has probable cause to believe the above-named defendant on the, 12 of February 2025 at 19:04 at 1721 GRAND ST. (Zone: f0) in Orange County did

On February 12th, 2025, at approximately 1904 hours, I, Officer Nicholas Terrett #31743 responded to the intersection of South Rio Grand Avenue and Indiana Street regarding a subject who had fled from officers after a hit and run incident. Officers on the scene provided a description of a black male wearing a black t-shirt who had fled on foot from the intersection and northwest through a residential neighborhood.

An emergency channel was established due to the subject fleeing and the eventual loss of sight of the subject after jumping multiple fences in the neighborhood. A cordon was established in the immediate area of where the subject was last seen, which was 1634 Columbia Street. Orlando Police Department K9 officers, in conjunction with Orange County Aviation Unit, conducted a thorough search of the surrounding area in an attempt to locate the individual in question. At approximately 2034 hours, Orange County Aviation Unit located the suspect jumping over fences in the area after the Orlando Police K9 officers came close to where the subject was hiding. This subject jumped multiple fences until he ended up in the backyard of 1721 Grand Street. While in the rear of this location, Orange County Aviation was able to observe this subject break a back window on the northwest corner of the residence and entered. The video of this action was captured and uploaded to Evidence.com. A smaller cordon was established around the 1721 Grand Street in an attempt to keep this subject from again fleeing the scene.

Through investigative means the property owner was identified as "The Village of Orlando LLC". The Property Maintenance Supervisor was eventually discovered through investigative means to reside at 1808 Grand Street and was contacted. Corporal E. Smith #18749 and myself went to the address in question and made contact with Allen Wiggins II, who was identified with a Florida Drivers License. Allen Wiggins explained 1721 Grand Street was an address he was personally responsible for through his role in The Village of Orlando LLC and no one had permission or authority to enter the residence. Allen Wiggins also informed us the property was vacant due to currently being in the process of a renovation. Allen Wiggins was able to make contact with his mother, Deborah Wiggins, who is the Vice President of The Village of Orlando LLC who confirmed the before mentioned facts. Allen Wiggins completed a sworn written statement to the before mentioned facts and stated he wished to press charges.

Based on the desire to press charges, at approximately 2154 hours loudspeaker announcements were made from the front of the residence identifying ourselves as the Orlando Police Department and directing the suspect inside to exit the residence. At approximately 2206 hours, announcements were also made at the rear of the residence directing the suspect to comply with officers. The subject attempted to exit from the rear of the home, and after making contact with the police, doubled back through the dwelling and exited from the front door where he ultimately surrendered. This male was detained and later identified with a DAVID inquiry as Dornell Bargnare.

Based on the circumstances of this investigation mainly; Bargnare's entering the residence without permission and his unwillingness to exit upon lawful order of officers on scene, probable cause exists to charge Dornell Bargnare with the following Florida State Statues:

1. 810.02(1)(B)(1)-4 – Burglary of a Dwelling
2. 843.02 – Resisting Officers without violence.

Dornell Bargnare was transported to Orlando Police Department Headquarters to be interviewed and eventually transported to Orange County Booking and Release Center without incident, in handcuffs which were checked for tightness.

Due to an active investigation into a Traffic Homicide incident (Florida Highway Patrol Case Number # FHP25ON0069263) this arresting
