**Count One: Failure to Comply with an Order or Signal of a Police Officer**

*The Jurors of the Grand Jury of the State of Ohio, within and for the body of Richland County, on their oaths, in the name and by the authority of the State of Ohio, do find and present:*

DAVID BROWN, on or about the 17th day of November, 2024, at the county of Richland aforesaid, did operate a motor vehicle so as willfully to elude or flee a police officer after receiving a visible or audible signal from a police officer to bring his motor vehicle to a stop in violation of Ohio Revised Code §2921.331(B), 2921.331(C)(3), **Failure to Comply with an Order or Signal of a Police Officer**, a felony of the fourth degree.

*The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.*

**Count Two: Trafficking in Marihuana**

*The Grand Jurors do further find and present:*

DAVID BROWN, on or about the 17th day of November, 2024, at the county of Richland aforesaid, did knowingly prepare for shipment, ship, transport, deliver, prepare for distribution, or distribute a controlled substance or a controlled substance analog, when the offender knows or has reasonable cause to believe that the controlled substance or a controlled substance analog is intended for sale or resale by the offender or another person and the drug involved in the violation is marihuana or a compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing marihuana other than hashish in an amount less than 200 grams in violation of Ohio Revised Code §2925.03(A)(2), 2925.03(C)(3)(a), **Trafficking in Marihuana**, a felony of the fifth degree.

**Specification for Forfeiture of Money in a Drug Case - §2941.1417(A)**

*The Grand Jurors further find and specify that:*

DAVID BROWN is the owner and/or possessor of \$1,026.00 in U.S. currency, which was contraband and/or property derived from or through the commission of the offense, and/or was an instrumentality the offender used or intended to use in the commission of or facilitation of the offense, to wit: said money being drug proceeds and/or used to purchase more drugs and/or drug paraphernalia and/or used to facilitate the transfer and/or transportation of drugs and/or drug paraphernalia.

*The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.*


