- (9) has unlawfully or recklessly used, displayed, or brandished a firearm;
- (10) has used, or threatened to use on a recurring basis, physical force against another person or has stalked another person;
- (11) has been arrested for, convicted of, had adjudication withheld, or pled *nolo contendere* to a crime involving violence or a threat of violence in Florida or in any other state;
- (12) has abused or is abusing controlled substances or alcohol;
- (13) has recently acquired firearms or ammunition;
- (14) is required to possess firearm(s) and/or ammunition in the scope and duties of their occupation;
- (15) has been the subject of proceedings under the Baker Act or Marchman Act;
- (16) Other (Additional relevant information may be included as attached exhibits. This may include reports or conclusions from a threat assessment team.).


#### **SECTION V. [TEMPORARY] RISK PROTECTION ORDERS**

I am a sworn law enforcement officer for ST. PETERSBURG POLICE  
(Agency)

I am over the age of 18, and submit this affidavit in support of obtaining a Risk Protection Order. I swear under penalty of law that on (date) 3/25/2026 there is a fear Respondent poses a significant danger of causing personal injury to self or others by having firearms/ammo in his/her custody/control or by purchasing, possessing, or receiving firearms/ammo. In support thereof, are the specific statements, or actions or facts that I heard/saw, which give rise to a reasonable belief that the Respondent poses such a danger, to wit:

RESPONDENT AND VICTIM ARE IN A DATING RELATIONSHIP AND ON THE LISTED DATE, TIME AND LOCATION, BECAME INVOLVED IN AN ALTERCATION IN THEIR HOME. DURING THE ALTERCATION, AFTER RESPONDENT NT BECAME AGGRESSIVE WITH THE VICTIM, SHE BEGAN RECORDING ON HER PHONE WHILE TELLING RESPONDENT TO NOT TOUCH HER. THE RESPONDENT T RETRIEVED A FIREARM FROM HIS NIGHTSTAND AND IS CAPTURED ON VIDEO BECOMING PHYSICAL WITH THE VICTIM. THE VICTIM STATES SHE IS GOING TO CALL THE POLICE AND IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING, RESPONDENT TAKES THE PHONE AWAY AND STOPS THE RECORDING. FOLLOWING THE RECORDING, RESPONDENT FORCEFULLY PRESSED THE FIREARM TO THE SIDE OF THE VICTIM'S HEAD, THREATENED TO KILL HER, AND THEN FORCED THE BARREL OF THE FIREARM INTO HER MOUTH; INJURY WAS OBSERVED TO THE VICTIM'S HEAD AND MOUTH WHICH WERE CONSISTENT WITH BOTH. RESPONDENT THREATENED TO KILL THE VICTIM UNTIL SHE WAS ABLE TO CALM HIM DOWN, AT WHICH TIME HE AGREED TO PLACE THE FIREARM, AS WELL AS A SECOND FIREARM, INSIDE HIS ASSIGNED WORK VEHICLE PARKED IN THE DRIVEWAY; SURVEILLANCE FOOTAGE CAPTURES THIS ACT AND THE FIREARM WAS LATER RECOVERED. RESPONDENT IS SWORN LAW ENFORCEMETN OFFICER.

The reason I think he/she poses a significant danger of causing personal injury to self or others is because: (List only the things you personally saw or heard, date it occurred, beginning with the most recent)

Tuesday, March 24, 2026, Brian and I were having a tense discussion where he became more and more upset. I started recording him for my own protection and he walked around the bed and grabbed his personal firearm, he then pulled the phone out of my hand and stopped recording. I reached

for my apple watch, which was on its charger and he took that while threatening me with the firearm. He forced me onto the bed in a sitting position and pressed the firearm to my left temple, he straddled me and then decided he was going to make me suffer and began

trying to gouge out my eyeballs. He then stopped that and proceeded to force the barrel of the firearm into my mouth. He then pulled me to the end of the bed, instructed me to stand, then instructed me to lay on the carpet face down though I refused to give access to my hands or arms. Then back against the end of the bed where

He did hold the firearm to his own head after I brought up his grandparents.

He/she has engaged in an act or threat of violence in the past 12 months:

Yes. September 28, 2025, where he held me captive for almost 6 hours threatening to kill our pets, me, and himself.

I believe that he/she is seriously mentally ill or has recurring mental health issues:

Yes. He's on antidepressants, which do not seem to work, and anti anxiety medication.

He/she has used, or threatened to use, any weapons against himself/herself or others:

Yes. As stated above.

He/she has unlawfully or recklessly used, displayed or brandished a firearm:

Yes. For both incidents.

He/she has used or threatened to use physical force against another person or stalked another person on a recurring basis:

Yes as to physical force. Unknown as to stalking though he did keep me under almost complete surveillance.

I believe that he/she abuses controlled substances or alcohol:

On occasion. When he drinks he frequently drinks to excess.

He/she has recently acquired firearms or ammunition:

Not that I am aware of. He only received a new firearm in relation to his duties as a deputy. That firearm was confiscated by HESO representatives.
