



AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Before me the undersigned authority on this day personally appeared Deputy Kyle Shelton 62, a Peace Officer of the State of Texas, who after being duly sworn upon oath deposes and says that he has good reason to believe and does believe that BRYANT, CHRISTIAN B/M DOB: [REDACTED] TXDL: [REDACTED] did commit the offense of UNLAWFUL CARRY WEAPONS PC 46.02, a CLASS A MISDEMEANOR., against the Laws of the State of Texas on the 12TH day of OCTOBER, A.D. 2025 in Van Zandt County, Texas.

AFFIANT HAS GOOD REASON TO BELIEVE AND DOES BELIEVE THAT:
BRYANT, CHRISTIAN Committed the crime of Unlawful Carry of Weapons PC 46.02 (MA).

MY BELIEF IS BASED UPON THE FOLLOWING FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES:

On 10/12/2025 at approximately 9:15 I, Deputy Shelton with the Van Zandt County Sherrifs Office responded to 9800 IH 20 (Pilot Truck Stop) in refrence to a possible welfare concern. While in route I received information from a trucking company, that a driver of one of their vehicles had triggered the on board camera in the cab of the truck. The footage depicted the driver holding a pistol by his head and pointing it at vehicles passing by while traveling on the interstate.

Deputies arrived on scene and located the vehicle backing out of the fuel station. While deputies approached the vehiclè the driver took a firearm off of the dashboard and threw it to the passenger side. Driver was non compliant with lawful commands given by deputies, therefore the driver was removed from the vehicle by law enforcement. The driver was then identified as Bryant, Christian b/m DOB [REDACTED].

While investigating the offense the firearm was located un holstered in the passenger seat. Subject was placed in custody. Deputies reviewed the onboard camera footage and observed subject holding a pistol and pointing it a vehicles as they were driving by. Later information revealed that the offense of deadly conduct did not occur in Van Zandt County. Information of the offense was passed on to Harrison County Sherrifs Office for further investigation of the offense that occurred in their jurisdiction.

Subject was then transported to the Van Zandt County Jail and booked in on the above charge of Unlawful Carry of Weapons PC 46.02 MA. I cleared with no further contact.
