Please consider this a notice of governmental claim, pursuant to California Government Code, Section 911.4 and to the extent this is deemed to be untimely, consider this a request/application to present a late Government Claim based on the fact that Mr. Robinson was in proper, not an attorney, and was unhoused (homeless) after the events in this claim.

Facts:

On or about October 22, 2025, Aerin Robinson an unarmed Black man, was approached by Burbank Police Department Officers. He was not under arrest or detained. He started to walk away because he was afraid of the officers. Without probable cause or justification, the Burbank Police Officers used unjustified and unreasonable force on Mr. Robinson causing him to bleed from his face and head. After causing extensive bleeding, the officers savagely took him to the ground and tased him multiple times. He told the officers, “you win” “I give up” but to no avail. Force and tasing continued. Mr. Robinson was seriously injured and required medical treatment. During the violent and terrifying ordeal, Mr. Robinson told the offices, “I can’t breathe” they simply mocked him for his ordeal. One more experienced and compassionate officer did say that is enough and prevented further serious injuries pain, suffering and emotional distress for Mr. Robinson.

Based on information and belief, this is not the first time that the responsible officers have engaged in excessive force on Black Americans. Based on information and belief, the defendants maliciously pursued criminal allegations against Mr. Robinson. Once the Court reviewed the Body Worn Camera (BWC) videos, the criminal charges were dismissed against Mr. Robinson.

D. GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF THE INJURY, DAMAGE OR LOSS INCURRED.

Economic and non economic losses. Pain, suffering, physical injuries. Punitive damages. Attorneys fees. Civil Penalties. Case costs. Such further relief as the Curt deems just.

2. All surveillance camera videos and images depicting any law enforcement interaction with Mr. Robinson, including but not limited to punching, kicking, grabbing, striking, tackling, hand cuffing, hog tying, tying the legs of Mr. Robinson, or otherwise touching him on or about October 22, 2025.
3. All police car camera videos and images depicting any law enforcement interaction with Mr. Robinson, including but not limited to punching, kicking, grabbing, striking, tackling, hand cuffing, hog tying, tying the legs of Mr. Robinson, or otherwise touching him on or about October 22, 2025.
4. All MDT, MCD, and other types of computer communications concerning Mr. Robinson on or about October 22, 2025.
5. All emails and other types of communications concerning Mr. Robinson on or about October 22, 2025 between any Burbank officers.
6. All dispatch and radio communications concerning Mr. Robinson on or about October 22, 2025.
7. The entire use-of-force investigation concerning the force used against Mr. Robinson on or about October 22, 2025.
8. The entire Internal Affairs Division's investigation(s) concerning misconduct in connection with Burbank Officers' interaction with Mr. Robinson on or about October 22, 2025, including without limitation all witness statements and conclusions of the investigation..
9. All police reports, incident reports, supplemental reports and other writings regarding the arrest on Mr. Robinson and all use of force reports.

G. THE AMOUNT OF CLAIMED DAMAGES EXCEEDS \$10,000.00 AND JURISDICTION WILL BE PROPER IN LOS ANGELES COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT.

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If you contend this is not the proper location for a Governmental Claim, please advise of the proper address. Further, if defendant contends there are any administrative claims or remedies not pursued by complainant, please advise so that we can fulfill any administrative remedy requirements now. Thank you.
