PROBABLE CAUSE:

On 3/11/2019 at approximately 0021 hours, I, Ofc. Blommel #134, responded as back-up for Ofc. Nickels #157 who was requesting assistance with an investigation in which the driver of a vehicle fled from him. I arrived on scene and began assisting K9 Ofc. Landry #329 in beginning a K9 track for the suspect. At the time of this incident, I was wearing my department issued blue police uniform with orange patches on both sleeves and a silver badge affixed to my left breast area.

Our track began in the south parking lot of the apartment complex located at 815 Gilmore Avenue. Ofc. Landry's K9 began tracking northbound through the complex on a sidewalk which was located directly in front of the front doors of the apartments. As we approached apartment #110, we observed several subjects loitering on the sidewalk directly in the path of our track. I observed that one of these subjects was a black male wearing a grey jacket. He was later identified via his Florida ID card as Iquan Isaac.

Ofc. Landry instructed Iquan to return to his apartment as his presence on the sidewalk was interfering with his police K9's ability to conduct his track. Iquan initially refused to enter the apartment and remained standing on the sidewalk. We issued several more commands to enter the apartment. Ofc. Landry's K9 partner was barking loudly at this time. Iquan began walking across the sidewalk to enter the apartment. At the same time, black female ran across the sidewalk while screaming. Iquan eventually, yet reluctantly, entered the apartment, but did not close the door behind himself. I yelled out, "Close the door, we are about to come by!" Iquan refused to close the door. I issued several additional verbal commands to close the door; however, Iquan refused these orders as well.

After attempting to have Iquan close the door and being unsuccessful, I stepped around Ofc. Landry and closed the door myself. We proceeded with our K9 track northbound on the sidewalk. Ofc. Landry advised that due to the interaction with Iquan, his K9 was no longer tracking effectively. We retraced our steps back southbound through the complex to restart the K9 track.

Ofc. Landry advised that we needed to restart the track near where the interaction with Iquan occurred. As we walked back to this location, I observed a shirtless black male standing on the sidewalk, just outside the open doorway of apartment #110. This male was later identified as Lorenzo Isaac via his Florida ID card. I yelled out to Lorenzo, "Go back inside now!" Lorenzo refused to obey my command. Ofc. Landry then yelled at Lorenzo, "Go inside or you are going to be charged!" Lorenzo again refused this lawful command.

I walked over to Lorenzo and stood in front of him, approximately two feet away. I ordered Lorenzo again to enter the apartment or he was going to be arrested. Lorenzo refused this third command and stood in the doorway while saying, "I don't have to go anywhere"

I told Lorenzo that he was being placed under arrest and reach out to grab his right arm. As I grabbed his arm and began pulling him away from the doorway, he violently pulled himself into the apartment. In doing this, I was pulled inside with him. I maintained my grip on Lorenzo's arm while reaching towards his left should with my free hand. Lorenzo began pushing me in the chest away from him. Lorenzo yelled at me, "You aren't gonna like what you get!" as he backed away towards the interior of the apartment. While still struggling with Lorenzo, I observed several additional subjects within the apartment approach me, grabbing me around my chest, waist, and arms. I observed that these three subjects were Iquan Isaac, Kevonte Isaac (ID by FLDL) and Kim Saddlers (ID by FLDL). These three subjects violently pulled me away from Lorenzo, causing me to lose my grasp on his body. The actions of these three subjects were against my will and malicious in nature. I drew my department issued CEW (TASER X26P S/N X12001W1W) from its holster and aimed it at Lorenzo's lower abdomen. I

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deployed the TASER which had no effect on Lorenzo. I managed to push myself away from the three subjects and again grabbed ahold of Lorenzo.

After battering me, Kim attempted to flee the scene through the front door. In doing so, she tripped and fell into the doorway near Ofc. Landry's K9. Kevonte ran to the open doorway and front kicked Ofc. Landry's K9 away from the front door. This caused Ofc. Landry's K9 to bit Kim. When Lorenzo observed Ofc. Landry's K9 latched onto Kim, He pushed me away and ran directly at Ofc. Landry. When Lorenzo reached Ofc. Landry, I observed him forcefully kick Ofc. Landry's K9 and at the same time, wind back his fist and strike Ofc. Landry in the face. I ran to Ofc. Landry's aid, wrapping my arms around Lorenzo's upper body, and dragging him to the ground. I restrained Lorenzo on the ground until additional officers arrived on scene.

Lorenzo was charged with maliciously striking a police K9, interfering with a police K9, and battery on a law enforcement officer.

Kim Saddler was charged with battery on a law enforcement officer.

Iquan Isaac was charged with interfering with a police K9 and battery on a law enforcement officer.

Kevonte Isaac was charged with battery on a law enforcement officer and maliciously striking a police K9. An FCIC/NCIC check of Kevonte revealed a Pasco County Sheriff's Office warrant for VOP on a traffic offense (Warrant # 2018CT001277CTAXES). This warrant was confirmed by LPD dispatch.
